

Dear colleagues,

the management of chronic middle ear disease is one of the most fascinating aspects in the field of Otorhinolaryngology. The surgical anatomy of the temporal bone is both appealing and challenging to grasp at the same time. Additionally, there are many different ways to treat the complex nature of chronic middle ear disease and hearing impairment. This course addresses young residents as well as experienced otorhinolaryngologists and all other professionals dealing with hearing impaired patients.

In order to give a comprehensive structure for hearing rehabilitation using classical microsurgery of the middle ear as well as modern hearing implant systems, this course is structured in:

1. lectures on basic principles of middle ear disease and microsurgery of the temporal bone,
2. commented live surgery with ultrahigh resolution 3D imaging, providing identical surgical views for participants and surgeons using a fully digital 3D microscope, and
3. systematic temporal bone exercises under supervision of experienced otosurgeons.

This course is held in conjunction with the Department of Otorhinolaryngology, Head and Neck Surgery, Martin Luther University Halle-Wittenberg.
